### NARRATIVE:

Anthony Stevens has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 18. His convictions include several assaults with a deadly weapons, damage to a jail, possession of a switchblade knife, multiple cases of battery, domestic violence with injury, vandalism, resisting arrest, trespassing, false identification to a peace officer, possession of a controlled substance, multiple cases of the use of PCP and interfering with public transportation. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 2 year term for domestic violence with injury. Stevens was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on April 1, 2014. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in February 2016 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Stevens qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for damage to a jail is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
