

**CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL ISSUES A CLOSURE OF HIGHWAY 14
DUE TO HIGH WINDS AND ZERO VISIBILITY CAUSED BY SANDSTORM**

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) has announced the closure of both Northbound and Southbound lanes on Highway 14 from Avenue A through D at 4:45 p.m. PDT on Tuesday, May 28, 2013.

The freeway closure is due to high winds that caused a sandstorm that has resulted in zero visibility to vehicle drivers. There is no timeframe for re-opening Highway 14 at this time.
