

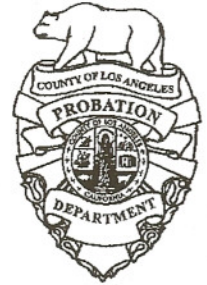

SUBJECT: **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH BOIL WATER ORDER FOR
CAMP DAVID GONZALES**

This is to advise your Board that the Department of Public Health issued a boil water order on March 18, 2009, after testing water and determining it was not safe to drink at Camp Gonzales.

Emergency precautions and actions have been implemented as follows:

- The boil water order is being followed;
- Bottled water is being provided for drinking and brushing of teeth;
- Camp Gonzales' kitchen is closed;
- All meals are being prepared at neighboring camps and transported to Camp Gonzales;
- ISD is starting the cleaning and repair of water tanks;
- Per the Health Department, water is safe for showering;
- Porta potties with hand wash stations are available should a disruption of water occur;
- All parents of youth shall be notified of the precautions and actions taken to assure the safety and well-being of the youth.

I will apprise the Board with more information as it becomes available.
