AUTHORIZE INTERNAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM THE ESTATE OF THE LATE LUCILE R. CRAWFORD (ALL DISTRICTS – 3 VOTES)

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

- 1. Approve and authorize the Director of Internal Services Department, as an agent for the County, to accept the donation of custom-made carved wood dining and entry room furniture, estimated value \$9,000. Furniture will be transferred to the Department of Human Resources Office of Public Safety for use in daily operations and can be viewed by the public at this facility.
- 2. Instruct the Executive Officer of the Board to send a letter of appreciation for the generous donation to the estate of Lucile R. Crawford, Malibu, California, in care of her attorney, Mr. Anthony Spaulding, 533 Lincoln Blvd., Santa Monica, CA 90402.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

In June, 2002, Mr. Anthony Spaulding, Esq., donated the furniture to the County upon a bequest from the estate of Lucile R. Crawford, that the furniture be used for public display. Twenty-nine pieces of custom-made 1920's carved wood furniture, valued at approximately \$9,000, were donated to the County of Los Angeles (see attachment).

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The recommended action will promote and further the County's Vision Statement by improving the quality and aesthetic appearance of community buildings for the benefit of the public. The furniture will be at the Office of Public Safety, 13001 Dahlia St., Downey, California 90242, and can be viewed by the public at this location.

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FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The only cost to the County in approving this action is the requirement to transport the furniture from storage to the Office of Public Safety's Downey office. Transportation costs are estimated at \$200 and will be funded from the Department of Human Resources' current operating budget.

Lucile R. Crawford, a former resident of Malibu, California, left a will directing the donation of furniture to the County of Los Angeles for public display.
