EXPANSION OF PROGRAM FOR A DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE

Pursuant to the provisions of the County of Los Angeles Drug-Free Workplace Program (Program) approved by the Board in February 1990, we are again expanding the Program to include additional classifications (attached) for which we will require preplacement drug testing of new hires to the County of Los Angeles. Individuals employed in these classifications perform safety-sensitive tasks such as operating motor vehicles and/or working with hazardous materials or powered equipment. These activities, if not safely performed, could have a significant adverse effect on public safety. The current list of pre-placement classifications subject to drug testing can be found at http://ceo.lacounty.gov/OHP/pdf/oh_drug.pdf.

This recommendation was generated during the course of review of Occupational Health Program's pre-placement medical testing protocols. Subsequently, members of my staff and the appropriate unions have approved the addition of this classification to the Program. This addition shall only apply to new hires of this classification, not employees currently assigned this classification.

Under the provisions of the Program, no action is required by the Board.
