MOBILE SPAY/NEUTER VEHICLE

On September 8, 2015, the Board of Supervisors directed the Department of Animal Care and Control and the Chief Executive Office to pursue an agreement with the Coalition for Pets and Public Safety for the donation of a new mobile spay/neuter vehicle valued at approximately \$500,000.00 and half the annual operating costs to operate the clinic. During the process of negotiating with the Coalition, it became apparent that in order to complete the donation process, a sole source agreement must be entered into by the County and the Coalition for Pets and Public Safety for the operation of the spay/neuter vehicle.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors direct the Department of Animal Care and Control to enter into a sole source agreement with the Coalition for Pets and Public Safety to receive the donation of the new spay/neuter vehicle and to operate the spay/neuter services.
