On January 4, 2016, a 19-year-old woman from Leona Valley was killed when her car hit an oak tree and plunged 20 feet down a ravine off Bouquet Canyon Road in Saugus. About 10 feet from the oak tree with which the young woman collided is a memorial marking the spot where a 16-year-old from Palmdale died after the car he was in also hit a tree on August 22, 2015. This stretch of Bouquet is owned by the United States Forest Service and the road is maintained by the County via permit. The County and Forest Service must work together with the California Highway Patrol and improve the safety of this road to avoid future fatalities.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors direct the Department of Public Works to work with the United States Forest Service and the California Highway Patrol and report back to the Board in 30 days with a plan on improving the safety of Bouquet Canyon Road.
