The Board regularly directs the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and our public safety departments to provide periodic status reports to keep the Board informed of all County efforts involving public safety. These efforts include the County's implementation of Assembly Bill 109, the implementation of recommendations made by the Citizens Commission on Jail Violence, the Developing Increased Safety Through Arms Recovery program, and many more. There may be opportunities to update, streamline or consolidate these reports in order to ensure that the Board has the most necessary information in the most useful format, and to minimize unnecessary burdens on County departments.

Undertaking this analysis may also present an opportunity for the County to update its knowledge of best practices for conveying information to decision-makers. In the course of optimizing the public safety reports received by the Board, the County
