Item 19 on this week's agenda authorizes the Director of ISD to accept \$21.7 Million in funding from the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to run the Southern California Regional Energy Network (SoCalRen), a program that the County administers to deliver energy efficiency programs in residential, non-residential, public and private sectors while working with local governments and public agencies across the southern California region.

Concurrently, ISD is working on a feasibility study for a Community Choice

Aggregation (CCA) program in Los Angeles County, which has the potential to provide

Los Angeles County residents with cheaper, cleaner energy. ISD has been submitting

bimonthly reports detailing their work studying a County CCA, and going forward, it

would be smart to include in the reports a discussion of potential synergistic

opportunities between this money the County receives from the CPUC to administer

SoCalRren, and the County's development of a CCA.

WE, THEREFORE, MOVE THAT the Board of Supervisors instruct the Director of ISD to include in their CCA reports a discussion of potential uses for this CPUC funding as it relates to the County's development of a Community Choice Aggregation program.
