On July 14, 2015, Norwalk Station Deputies along with Sheriff Homicide
Investigators responded to the 12300 block of Gettysburg Drive in the City of Norwalk, regarding a shots fired call. Upon arrival, along with the Los Angeles County Fire
Department, they discovered two dead males inside the residence. The victims, 49year old Walter Vincente and his son, 24-year old Andrew Vicente both sustained apparent gunshot wounds to the head. Investigators determined that the victims were not gang members.

Investigators believe it would be beneficial to offer a reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individual(s) responsible for this crime. They may remain anonymous. As of this date, no additional witnesses have come forward. The Board of Supervisors established this reward for \$10,000 on October 27, 2015; however, since the reward expired on January 24, 2016, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department has requested that it be reinstated.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors reestablish the offer of a
