NATURE OF CASE

This is a recommendation to settle for \$2,500,000, the lawsuit filed by Liam Mulligan alleging civil rights violations when he was wrongfully shot in the leg by Sheriff's Deputies responding to an emergency call.

The involved Deputies claim their actions were reasonable under the circumstances.

Due to the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a reasonable settlement at this time will avoid further litigation costs. Therefore, a full and final settlement of the case in the amount of \$2,500,000 is recommended.
