REQUEST FOR APPROVAL AND AWARD OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT SERVICES MASTER AGREEMENTS (ALL DISTRICTS - 3 VOTES)

JOINT RECOMMENDATION WITH THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER THAT YOUR BOARD:

- 1. Authorize the Director, Internal Services Department (ISD), or his designee, to execute Information Technology Support Services Master Agreements (ITSSMA), with the 146 companies listed on Attachment 1, effective October 1, 2006 for an initial term of five (5) years and with two (1) one-year extensions exercisable by the Director, ISD, or his designee.
- Authorize the Director, ISD or his designee to execute agreements with new vendors as the vendors become qualified under the ITSSMA throughout the term of the Master Agreement and execute applicable agreement amendments when the original contracting entity has merged, been purchased or has otherwise changed.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

ISD currently administers the ITSSMA program which provides a pool of readily available prequalified providers of information technology professionals available to help County departments effectively use information technology to carry out their missions. Professional services are competitively bid and awarded to prequalified contractors in specific service or skill categories on a project by project basis. The current Master Agreement expires on September 30, 2006. There is a continuing need to obtain these professional services to assist the County in implementing technology projects and providing other needed information technology support. Your Board's approval of the proposed new ITSSMA will allow ISD and other County departments to continue to obtain information technology professional services.

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Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The recommended action supports the Countywide Strategic Plan Goal Number 1, Service Excellence; Goal Number 3, Organizational Effectiveness; and Goal Number 4, Fiscal Responsibility by effectively managing County resources.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

Expenditures under these agreements will vary from year to year based on the needs of County departments. Departments have the responsibility for ensuring they have adequate funding prior to requesting services under this Master Agreement. Funding for these services is included in the Fiscal Year 2006-07 adopted ISD and departments' budgets. Subsequent year funding will be requested in the Fiscal Year budgets for each annual term and any extensions. Expenditures over the term of the agreements in any given year will remain within each department's budgeted appropriation for such services. Contractors will not be asked to perform services which exceed the amounts, scope of work and dates specified in each individual work order. As has been the policy under the current ITSSMA, departments will continue to be required to notify your Board of any ITSSMA projects that exceed \$300,000 prior to work order execution or amendment.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The terms and conditions of the proposed Master Agreement have been approved as to form by County Counsel and are the same as the current ITSSMA. It contains the Board's required contract provisions including those pertaining to consideration of qualified County employees targeted for layoff as well as qualified GAIN/GROW participants for employment openings, and compliance with the Jury Service Ordinance, Safely Surrendered Baby Law and the Child Support Program.

The current ITSSMA that was approved by your Board on September 21, 1999 contains the same liability language limiting a contractor's liability to an amount equal to the maximum amount of each work order and excluding certain categories of damages. Based on our past experience, this limitation has been sufficiently high enough to provide a reasonable and acceptable protection to the County. The recommended Master Agreement contains the same language as the current Master Agreement.

ITSSMA is not a Proposition A agreement due to the technical nature of the services provided and, therefore, not subject to the Living Wage Program (County Code Chapter 2.201). It has been determined that the services under these agreements do not impact Board Policy No. 5.030, "Low Cost Labor Resource Program", because of the specialized training needed to perform the work.

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CONTRACTING PROCESS

All current ITSSMA contractors will be asked to execute the new Master Agreement in order to continue their eligibility to bid on new project work orders. New vendors may qualify for a Master Agreement at any time by submitting a Statement of Qualifications. These vendors will be added to the Master Agreement if they meet the minimum requirements (e.g., technical qualifications, references, etc.) for being an ITSSMA contractor. Thereafter, they will from time to time be solicited under competitive conditions to provide information technology professional services under work orders executed by ISD.

However, approval of the Master Agreement does not guarantee a contractor any minimum amount of business. The County only incurs an obligation as individual work orders are issued. All active contractors can bid on services and receive work order availability notices released in the ITSSMA categories where the contractor has been prequalified. Awards will be made to the lowest priced qualified contractor unless other selection criteria are set forth in the work order availability notice. Contractors certified as a Local Small Business Enterprise (LSBE) will receive the 5% LSBE preference on their individual work order bids.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Approval of the recommendations will ensure that ISD and County departments continue to receive information technology professional services.
