AMENDMENT TO ITEM #3 – REQUEST TO FIRST FIVE LA TO PRESERVE BLACK INFANT HEALTH PROGRAM

In addition to the programs supervised by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, the cities of Long Beach and Pasadena also run Black Infant Health Programs that have been negatively impacted by the State budget cuts.

- I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors request that First 5 LA allocate \$172,964 each to the Cities of Long Beach and Pasadena to support their Black Infant Health Programs, and allow them to draw down the respective federal matching dollars.
- I, FURTHER, MOVE that First 5 increase the allocation to the Department of Public Health by an additional \$50,000 in order to increase the allocation for the Black Infant Health Program in the Antelope Valley where the infant mortality among African Americans continues to rise at an alarming rate.
