**Dear Assembly Member Adams:** 

We are writing to respectfully urge you to enact a State Budget that provides a balanced approach to meeting the State's fiscal crisis while maintaining vital services to the residents of the Los Angeles County.

The County administers numerous programs on behalf of the State, which are essential to provide critical safety net services. However, the vast majority of the County Budget (\$19.1 billion or 83.6 percent) is mandatory and beyond the control of our Board and only \$3.7 billion (16.4 percent) is within our authority. Most of our resources are already committed to fund public safety services such as the Sheriff, the District Attorney, the Probation Department, and lifeguards, and to help support the Department of Health Services and homeless programs.

When the FY 2008-09 Special Session Budget and FY 2009-10 State Budget Act were enacted earlier this year, Los Angeles County sustained a loss of \$253.1 million. This latest State fiscal crisis has yet again placed funding for services vital to the health, safety, and well-being of the County's 10 million residents at risk. Coupled with the severe economic downturn, the County is struggling to maintain vital services to all of its residents at a time when demand for these services continues to increase.

We realize that addressing this fiscal crisis will require difficult decisions and sacrifices to produce a budget that strikes fair balance between all stakeholders, but we believe that ultimately finding a sensible "common sense" solution that will help rebuild the State's economy while maintaining critical services is in the best interest of all Californians.

We are writing to respectfully urge you to enact a State Budget that provides a balanced approach to meeting the State's fiscal crisis while maintaining vital services to the residents of the Los Angeles County.

The County administers numerous programs on behalf of the State, which are essential to provide critical safety net services. However, the vast majority of the County Budget (\$19.1 billion or 83.6 percent) is mandatory and beyond the control of our Board and only \$3.7 billion (16.4 percent) is within our authority. # MOTION BY SUPERVISORS MOLINA AND YAROSLAVSKY

June 22, 2009

## **COMMON SENSE BUDGET**

California's budget crisis threatens to undermine the quality of life in our communities and the welfare of the people of Los Angeles County.

The Governor's "cuts only" budget proposal would deprive millions of Californians basic health care, home care and other services that children, seniors, and people with disabilities need to survive; and

The Governor's budget proposal would leave hundreds of thousands of people unemployed—including Los Angeles County residents—putting enormous pressure on County services and driving California further into recession.

The Governor's budget proposal would significantly cut money that the state is legally required to pay to counties, which in turn would catastrophically impact the Los Angeles County budget, impact public safety, and impact vital services which are needed to maintain our strong and vibrant communities.


