RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES

LAUNCHING THE BRAG ABOUT YOUR BAG® CAMPAIGN THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES

WHEREAS, each year, approximately 6 billion single use plastic carryout bags are used in Los Angeles County; and,

WHEREAS, in the United States, less than 5 percent of single use plastic bags are recycled; and,

WHEREAS, the indiscriminate littering of single use bags creates significant litter problems for Los Angeles County streets, beaches, and the marine environment; and,

WHEREAS, each year, the State of California spends approximately \$25 million to landfill discarded single use plastic bags; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles has set solid waste reduction and recycling goals, and is taking action to reduce the litter impacts of single use carryout bags; and,

WHEREAS, reusable bags contribute towards environmental sustainability over single use carryout bags as well as significantly reduce single use bag litter; and,

WHEREAS, Heal the Bay and its community partners, including the County of Los Angeles, have established the third Thursday of December, each year, as "A Day Without a Bag" which urge shoppers to forego single use bags in favor of reusable bags; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles has invited NBA World Champion basketball star Luke Walton to participate and pledge to take a leadership role in promoting public awareness about the benefits of using a reusable shopping bags; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles hereby proclaim the launching of the Brag About Your Bag® campaign on November 15, 2009 to encourage environmental stewardship in Los Angeles County.
