LOS ANGELES COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICTS AND THE MARINA DEL REY WATER SYSTEM WATER RATE ADJUSTMENT (SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS 3, 4, AND 5) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

This action is to adopt a resolution adjusting the water rates for calendar year 2010 to pass through wholesale water cost increases from the wholesale water agencies serving the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and the Marina del Rey Water System, and authorize the Director of Public Works or her designee to amend the Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System to implement the increase 30 days after adjustment notices are sent to customers.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICTS AND MARINA DEL REY WATER SYSTEM:

- 1. Find that the purpose of adjustments to the water rates shown in the Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System are to meet the operating expenses necessary to maintain service within existing service areas and, therefore, are statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act.
- 2. Adopt the resolution to adjust the water rates for calendar year 2010 to pass through wholesale water cost increases from the wholesale water agencies serving the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and the Marina del Rey Water System.
- 3. Authorize the Director of Public Works or her designee to amend Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System to implement the water rate increase effective 30 days after adjustment notices are sent to customers.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The purpose of the recommended action is to adjust water rates to offset wholesale water cost increases adopted by wholesale water agencies serving the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and the Marina del Rey Water System (Waterworks Districts).

Currently, the Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System (Rules and Regulations) allow the Waterworks Districts to annually review water rates and make a recommendation to your Board for rate adjustments.

Water wholesale rates adopted by wholesale water agencies have increased significantly (Enclosure A). Wholesale water costs account for a portion of the retail cost of water. The Waterworks Districts' Financial Officer and the Auditor-Controller reviewed the Waterworks Districts' rates and determined that the retail water rates be adjusted by 6.6 percent in Waterworks District No. 21, Kagel Canyon; 13.1 percent in Waterworks District No. 29, Malibu; 23.4 percent in Waterworks District No. 36, Val Verde; 4.0 percent in Waterworks District No. 37, Acton; 3.8 percent in Waterworks District No. 40, Antelope Valley; and 19.9 percent in the Marina del Rey Water System.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The Countywide Strategic Plan directs the provision of Operational Effectiveness (Goal 1) and Community and Municipal Services (Goal 3) by providing sufficient funds to offset increases in wholesale water charges to maintain reliable delivery of water service to County residents within the Waterworks Districts.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

There will be no impact to the County General Fund.

This action will generate additional annual revenue in water sales, to pay for the increased cost of wholesale water, of approximately \$10,700 in Waterworks District No. 21, Kagel Canyon; \$2,041,000 in Waterworks District No. 29, Malibu; \$187,000 in Waterworks District No. 36, Val Verde; \$37,000 in Waterworks District No. 37, Acton; \$1,150,000 in Waterworks District No. 40, Antelope Valley; and \$250,000 in the Marina del Rey Water System to offset increased purchased water costs in each Waterworks District's respective General Fund. The rate adjustments will become effective 30 days after adjustment notices are sent to customers.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Your Board is authorized to increase the water rates, surcharges, and water supply charges pursuant to Section 55501 of the County Waterworks District Law, Water Code Section 65000, et. seq. Adoption of this resolution (Enclosure B) will allow revisions to the Waterworks Districts' Rules and Regulations (Enclosure C) adopted pursuant to Section 55333 of the Waterworks Districts' Law. County Counsel has reviewed and approved the proposed resolution.

Section 53756 of the California Government Code states that "An agency providing water, sewer, or refuse collection service may adopt a schedule of fees or charges authorizing automatic adjustments that pass through increases in wholesale charges for water or adjustments for inflation..." A notice of the adjustments will be given pursuant to Subdivision (a) of Section 53755 of the Government Code within 30 days before the effective date of the adjustment.

Consistent with the requirements of Section 66016 of the Government Code, the Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on the matter of annual rate adjustments on November 24, 2009, and consistent with California Constitution Article 13, Section 6 (Proposition 218), Sections 66018 and 6062a of the Government Code, a Notice of the Public Hearing was mailed to all affected customers and property owners more than 45 days in advance of the date of the public hearing. Seven written protests were received prior to the public hearing. Also, in compliance with these Government Code Sections, a notice of the time and place of the hearing was published two times in a newspaper of general circulation within a ten-day period with at least five intervening days. After the public hearing, your Board approved the required resolution, subject to annual rate increase approval by your Board.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the proposed resolution as to form.

Wholesale water rate increases for 2010 will be passed through to the Waterworks Districts' customers in accordance with Government Code Section 53756. There was no pass-through cost for inflation as determined by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, for the Los Angeles, Riverside, and Orange County areas.

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ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

These actions and the resolution, amending the Waterworks Districts' Rules and Regulations, are to fund operating expenses and, therefore, are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 21080(b)(8) of the Public Resources Code and Section 15273(a) of the CEQA Guidelines.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

There will be no impact on current County services or projects as a result of this action.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS OR HER DESIGNEE TO ADJUST THE WATER RATES FOR THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICTS AND MARINA DEL REY WATER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System (hereinafter referred to as DISTRICTS) provide potable water service to customers located within the Cities of Malibu, Lancaster, and Palmdale and within the unincorporated communities of Kagel Canyon, Marina del Rey, Topanga Canyon, Castaic, Acton, Pearblossom, Littlerock, Rock Creek, and Lake Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors (hereinafter referred to as BOARD) as the governing body of the DISTRICTS pursuant to Section 55501 of the County Waterworks District Law, Water Code, is authorized to increase the water rates, surcharges, and water supply charges as adopted in the Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System pursuant to Section 55333; and

WHEREAS, the Rules and Regulations of the Los Angeles County Waterworks Districts and Marina del Rey Water System requires the District Engineer to annually review the water rate schedules and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors for water rate adjustments; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICTS purchase wholesale water from water wholesalers as needed; and

WHEREAS, Section 53756 of the California Government Code states that "An agency providing water, sewer, or refuse collection service may adopt a schedule of fees or charges authorizing automatic adjustments that pass through increases in wholesale charges for water or adjustments for inflation..."; and

WHEREAS, on November 24, 2009, after a public hearing the BOARD adopted a resolution pursuant to Section 53756 of the California Government Code to adjust the water rates to pass through the costs increases due to inflation and/or the cost of purchasing water from wholesale water agencies for the DISTRICTS, subject to review and approval by the BOARD; and

WHEREAS, DISTRICTS' retail price of water is partially dependent upon the DISTRICTS' cost of the purchase of wholesale water; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the DISTRICTS to pass through wholesale water charge increases to its retail customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, as the governing body of the DISTRICTS does hereby authorize the Director of Public Works or her designee to adjust the water rates and fees as outlined in Enclosure C to become effective 30 days after adjustment notices are sent to customers to pass through increased water cost due to increases in wholesale water charges.

PART 2 RATE SCHEDULES AND SERVICE CHARGES FOR USE OF WATER

SECTION A - WATER USE DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL AND AGRICULTURAL USES

The rates to be charged and collected for water and water service supplied in any one month for domestic, commercial, industrial and agricultural uses within Waterworks Districts are established in this Section.

2-A-1 CHARGE FOR METERED SERVICE: Where there are more than one house, store, etc., on a parcel of land under one ownership, the District will, at the option of the District, serve the houses, stores, etc., through one or more water meters. The District will render one water bill for each of the water meters serving the premises.

Each separate ownership will be served through separate water meters.

The charge for water service through each meter will be determined by the addition of the established Service Charge, which is an amount for each size of meter, and of the total Quantity Charge, (including applicable assessments) for the consumption of water, either indicated by the District water meter or estimated by the District. In addition, some Districts have other charges for specific purposes as approved by the Board of Directors and defined within this section.

2-A-1 CHARGE FOR METERED SERVICE: (Continued)

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE: The fixed monthly rate to be charged and collected for each service to a private fire protection system shall be the applicable District minimum rates per billing unit, and the billing units for this service are related to the detector check valve size as follows:

Size of Detector Check Valve	Billing Units
4-inch and smaller	2.9
6-inch	3.9
8-inch	4.9
10-inch	6.9
12-inch	10.9

The number of billing units for all other type meters and for multiple meter assemblies of any type or various type meters shall be determined by dividing the on-site domestic demand in gpm by 30 gpm.

2-A-1a SERVICE AND QUANTITY CHARGE

SERVICE CHARGE is defined as the minimum charge determined by the number of billing units, which is based upon the size of meter. With the exception of detector check meter, this minimum charge provides for 500 cubic feet of water per billing unit per month. Private Fire Protection Service (detector check) meters are solely for the purpose of fire protection. Therefore, no water usage is allowed for or included in the service charge allowance. All water consumed shall be billed at the Quantity Charge rate of the applicable District. See also RULE 1-H-2.

2-A-1a SERVICE AND QUANTITY CHARGE (Continued)

QUANTITY CHARGE is defined as a consumption charge for all water used in excess of the service charge allowance with the exception of detector check meter. For Private Fire Protection Service (detector check) meters, the Quantity Charge is defined as a consumption charge for all water used. See also RULE 1-H-2.

- 2-A-1b FIGURING MINIMUM CHARGE STANDARD: The minimum Service Charge per month is determined by multiplying the minimum charge of one billing unit by the total number of billing units for that meter size and entitles the customer to the quantity of water determined by multiplying the number of billing units by 500 cubic feet. All water used in excess thereof per month shall be sold in accordance with the Quantity Charge without regard to the number of billing units. This rule does not apply to detector check meters. See Rule 2-A-1a.
- 2-A-1c CONTRIBUTING FACTORS NEEDED FOR ADJUSTING WATER RATE: The Engineer may, after an evaluation of fixed costs and expenses which routinely affect the operating costs of a District, administratively adjust the water rate schedule to reflect any changes in these costs and expenses.

Annually on July 1, the Engineer shall review said fixed costs and adjust the District's water rate schedule to compensate for changes in operating costs as affected thereby. The adjusted rate shall be effective approximately thirty (30) days after making the review and notifying the District's customers of the new schedule.

The routine fixed costs and expenses are defined as follows:

- Cost of water purchased.
- Cost of electrical energy and other fuels.
- Salary and wages.
- 4. Overhead costs including costs applied by the County of Los Angeles.

CONTRIBUTING FACTORS NEEDED FOR ADJUSTING WATER RATE: 2-A-1c (Continued)

For a District where a portion of the financing of the construction of new and replacement water facilities such as water mains, is derived from a property tax levy and the operating and maintenance expense is paid in part from taxes, the Engineer for the District may establish a water rate schedule for water service to publicly owned premises which do not pay District taxes at higher rates than applicable for water service to tax-paying premises. The higher schedule may not exceed by more than 10 percent, the schedule established for tax-paying premises and may only be applicable for fiscal years in which the District levies taxes for the herein described purposes.

2-A-25a WATER SOLD TO CUSTOMERS OUTSIDE DISTRICT. The total monthly charge for water sold to customers entirely outside the District shall be 150 percent of the total monthly charge for water sold to customers in the nearest applicable water service area within the District in addition to any other applicable charges.

See RULE 2-A-4j for Facilities Construction Surcharge.

2-A-25b WATER SOLD TO CUSTOMERS PARTLY OUTSIDE DISTRICT. The total monthly charge for water sold to customers partly outside the District shall be 125 percent of the total monthly charge for water sold to customers in the nearest applicable water service area entirely within the District in addition to any other applicable charges.

SECTION B - WATER RATES FOR MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES

2-B-4 CONSTRUCTION WATER SERVICE (Metered): The District shall require that all water used for construction purposes be metered. The District will furnish, install, and remove the meter, valve, and fittings to be located at a fire hydrant or other convenient point in the system as determined by the District. The customer shall be responsible for the loss of or damage to the meter and other equipment used therefor. The charge for the metering facility is to guarantee the return of the meter to the District in an operative manner. The installation and removal charge shall be as follows:

2-inch and smaller meter	\$ 146.00
2 1/2-inch flow tube fire hydrant meter	165.00
3-inch meter	249.00
4-inch meter	412.00

For the District to relocate the meter from one location to another location at the request of the Customer, the charge is as follows:

2-inch and smaller meter	\$ 63.00
2 1/2-inch meter	78.00
3-inch meter	145.00
4-inch meter	240.00

The charges for installation, removal, and relocation of the meters larger than 4-inch or for meters 4-inch and smaller requiring an extraordinary installation, will be on an estimated basis of current costs.

The installation, removal, and relocation charges shall become revenue to the District.
