Re-establish Reward Offer – Dannie Farber, Jr.

On Sunday, May 24, 2009, at approximately 9:40 P.M., 18-year old Dannie Farber, Jr. was shot and killed while eating dinner with his girlfriend at a restaurant located on the 1900 block of Rosecrans Avenue in the City of Compton. An unknown assailant walked into the restaurant and shot Dannie four times. Dannie tragically succumbed to his wounds shortly thereafter.

Dannie was a senior at Narbonne High School and was set to graduate in June of 2009. He was a good student, a star All-City wide receiver on the Narbonne High School Gauchos football team, and had received a football scholarship to attend college.

Dannie was taken prematurely from his family, friends and classmates, and was not given the opportunity to fulfill his potential. The detectives from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Homicide Bureau have worked diligently and relentlessly in
