On Sunday, August 10, 2008, at approximately 11:35 p.m., four Hispanic males were shot while attending a gathering for car enthusiasts at Western Avenue and Imperial Highway in the unincorporated area of Los Angeles.

Jose Farias, Victor Farias, and Vidal Rebolledo were shot after an altercation with two male Hispanic suspects and died as a result of their wounds. A fourth Hispanic male, Jose De Jesus Garcia, was also shot, was treated St. Francis Medical Center and later released.

Both suspects exited a dark-colored, 2-door vehicle and one of them began shooting at the victims. Following the shooting, both suspects re-entered the vehicle and fled the area. There were many witnesses at the scene with cameras and video cameras, but no one has come forth with any information.

On September 16, 2008, this Board approved a \$10,000 reward offer which expired on December 15, 2008. The Sheriff's Homicide investigators are requesting that the reward be re-established.
