Proposed Schedule for the Ford Amphitheatre 2011 Season

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

- 1. Approve the proposed roster for the John Anson Ford Amphitheatre's 2011 season.
- 2. Authorize the Executive Director to make the necessary expenditures within the approved 2010-2011 budget to implement the program.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

This is the annual implementation of the 2011 Summer Partnership Program, a summer performing arts series in the historic Ford Amphitheatre. The Summer Partnership Program, running from May through October, supports Los Angeles County resident arts organizations by assisting them to successfully present performances in the Ford's 1,200-seat amphitheatre. The Arts Commission provides presentation support to participating arts organizations which, in turn, provide the residents of Los Angeles County with a rich cultural sampling of performing arts of the region.

The roster proposed for the 2011 Summer Partnership Program season includes thirty-five arts organizations producing forty-nine events. The proposed roster brings fourteen new arts organizations to the Ford season. It is anticipated that the Ford Theatre Foundation will provide resources for approximately eight additional performances for young audiences and a free series of participatory art workshops. Overall, the proposed schedule is consistent with previous Ford Amphitheatre seasons, reflecting the artistic merit, cultural diversity and geographic range of Los Angeles County.

The Arts Commission began programming the John Anson Ford Amphitheatre in 1993. To schedule the 2011 Ford summer season, Arts Commission staff sent requests for proposals to more than 700 Los Angeles County arts organizations; 54 applications were received and reviewed. Selections were based on artistic merit, producing experience, fiscal stability, suitability of proposed project to the venue and diversity in programming. On October 4, 2010, the Arts Commissioners reviewed and unanimously approved the attached proposed roster.

<u>Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals</u>

The recommended action is consistent with the County Strategic Plan Goal 3, Strategy 1 to increase accessibility to County cultural, recreational and lifelong learning facilities and programs, as the proposed 2011 series will provide the public with affordable access to quality arts programs through public private partnerships with the Los Angeles arts community.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

Funds have been allocated for this purpose as part of the Arts Commission's Fiscal Year 2010-2011 budget. Additional revenue comes from rental of the theatre, concessions, and donations from the Ford Theatre Foundation. There were 33 theatre rentals during the 2010 summer season and the Ford Theatre Foundation has raised \$235,000 for the 2010 calendar year from the following public and private sources: Angell Foundation, Boeing Employees Community Fund, City of Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs, City of Los Angeles Councilmember Tom LaBonge, Flourish Foundation, James Irvine Foundation, Kenneth T. and Eileen L. Norris Foundation, Macy's, National Endowment for the Arts, NBC Universal, Sony Pictures, Weingart Foundation, Wells Fargo and individual donors. Proposals with requests totaling \$790,000 are currently pending. The Ford Theatre Foundation raised a total of \$349,000 from public and private sources in 2009, the organization's most recently completed fiscal year.
