<u>SUBSTITUTE MOTION - ALTA MED HEALTH SERVICES</u>

In a media story that aired yesterday it was reported that the CEO of one of our Private Public Partners, Alta Med Health Services, received a \$400,000 salary increase between 2008 and 2010. His current salary, according to the media report, totals \$797,000.

This salary is very high and the increase over a two-year period is significant. Of particular concern is that this agency's revenue is, in large part, based on public taxpayer dollars.

This media report included comments from the Governor and State Assemblyman Allan Mansoor from Costa Mesa. Both expressed concerns over the CEO's compensation.

In consideration of the fact that this agency is funded by multiple state, federal and local government funding sources and operates in both Los Angeles and Orange Counties, the most appropriate agency to perform a review of this matter is the Office of the State Auditor.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board send a letter to the Office of the State Auditor requesting the Bureau of State Audits to conduct an evaluation of the pay structure of this agency to ensure that taxpayer dollars are being spent appropriately.
