**REWARD OFFER (DODGERS' INCIDENT)**

On April 5, 2011, this Board approved an offer of a \$10,000 reward in exchange for information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the suspects who were responsible for the unprovoked and senseless attack on Bryan Stow, a 41-year-old father of two children and a paramedic.

Bryan Stow and his friends were attacked for their affiliation with the San Francisco Giants on Dodgers' opening night at approximately 8:25 p.m. in Section 2 of the parking lot at approximately 8:25 p.m.

The Los Angeles Police Department still needs the public's assistance in their search for the two suspects who taunted and severely assaulted Bryan Stow.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors reestablish and increase the reward offer to \$25,000 in exchange for information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the suspects who were responsible for the unprovoked and senseless attack on Bryan Stow, a 41-year-old father of two children and a paramedic, and his friends for their affiliation with the San Francisco Giants on Dodgers' opening night at approximately 8:25 p.m. in Section 2 of the parking lot.
