HAYDEN LAW

Governor Jerry Brown has announced plans to eliminate the "Hayden Law", which requires animal shelters to:

- 1. hold animals four to six days before they can be euthanized;
- 2. post lost-and-found lists for owners to locate pets; and
- those choosing to only hold an animal for four days, to remain open so owners can pick up their pet.

Last year in Los Angeles County, over 1,100 animals were returned to their owners, and many more animals were adopted during the time they were held in the animal shelters.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors send a 5-signature letter to Governor Jerry Brown requesting that he not repeal the Hayden Law.
