## MOTION BY SUPERVISOR MICHAEL D. ANTONOVICH JUNE 26, 2012

On July 26, 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved the Crescenta Valley Dog Park Project (Capital Project No. 69696), allocating County Excess Funds in the amount of \$645,000 for a grant to the Los Angeles Conservation Corps to construct the County's first dog park in Crescenta Valley Community Regional Park.

When constructing a new facility, it is required to provide a path of travel to the nearest restroom. Both the path of travel and the restroom must comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The closest restroom to the new dog park is not compliant with ADA and there is not an accessible path of travel to it from the dog park. To comply with ADA, the Department of Parks and Recreation (the Department) is requesting that the Board approve additional scope of work to upgrade the existing restroom and construct an accessible path of travel from the dog park to it. The Fifth Supervisorial District has committed \$120,000 to the Department for the upgrades. The funds are contingent on the Board's approval of the Mid Year and Final Changes Board letters on the June 25, 2012 Board Agenda. After the funding is approved, the work will be completed through a Job Order Contract and completed by August 27, 2012 for Grand Opening of the dog park.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approve the additional scope of work to bring the path of travel and restrooms into compliance with ADA.
- 2. Approve the allocation of \$120,000 of County Excess Funds available to the Fifth Supervisorial District pursuant to the Safe Neighborhood Parks Proposition of 1996 to upgrade the restrooms and path of travel to comply with ADA.
