## <u>Showcasing the County of Los Angeles through the Seventh International</u> <u>Conference on Social Work</u>

The County of Los Angeles (County) is a leader in its efforts to provide integrated health, mental health and substance abuse services in preparation for the implementation of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) in 2014. The 7<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Social Work in Health and Mental Health is scheduled for Sunday, June 23, 2013, through Thursday, June 27, 2013, at the USC Ronald Tutor Campus Center. The County has a great opportunity to showcase this unprecedented effort to integrate care delivery by having the departments of Mental Health, Health Services, Public Health, and Children and Family Services co-organize the event with the University of Southern California School of Social Work.
