RESOLUTION NO. 15-5241

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA PUENTE, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2016

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of La Puente, California ("City"), on April 12, 2016; and

WHEREAS, in the course of conduct of the election it is necessary for the City to request certain services from the County of Los Angeles ("County"); and

WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing these services shall be paid by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA PUENTE HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of California Elections Code section 10002, the City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of the County to permit the County of Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to prepare and furnish the following for use in conducting the City's election:

1. A listing of County precincts with number of registered voters in each, so the City may consolidate election precincts into City voting precincts; and maps of the voting precincts;
2. A list of polling places and poll workers the County uses for its elections;
3. The computer record of the names and addresses of all eligible registered voters in the City in order that the City's consultant may:
 - a. Produce labels for vote-by-mail voters;
 - b. Produce labels for sample ballot pamphlets;
 - c. Print rosters of voters and street indexes;
4. Voter signature verification services as needed;
5. Make available to the City, election supplies, equipment and assistance necessary to conduct the election in accordance with state law.

SECTION 2. The City shall reimburse the County for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.


SECTION 3. The City Clerk is directed to forward without delay, a copy of this Resolution, to the County Board of Supervisors and to the County of Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this resolution are severable and if any provision, clause, sentence, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, sections, words or parts thereof of the Resolution or their applicability to other persons or circumstances.


SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
