## FACILITY/GROUP INSPECTION REPORTS

#### Child Focus Group Home - #11-2

Commissioners Moore and Bacio visited this facility on June 21<sup>st</sup> and were unable to conduct an inspection due to police activity on the premises involving an out of control/runaway minor being returned to the home.

#### Glass/St. Andrews House - #48-2

Commissioner Bacio visited this facility on June 16<sup>th</sup> and gave a rating of **Satisfactory** with <u>no areas of concern</u> observed or reported. Commissioner Bacio noted that the new facility staff is competent and attentive; things are now under control and the facility maintained.

## Teen's Happy Homes - #103-2

Commissioners Russell and Hammargren visited this facility on June 20<sup>th</sup> and gave a rating of **Satisfactory** with <u>no areas of concern</u> observed or reported. Commissioners noted that facility staff is working to motivate residents; a follow-up inspection should be scheduled in six months.

## **Creative Learning Institute - #23-2**

Chair Montano and Commissioner Hammargren visited this facility on June 16<sup>th</sup> and gave a rating of **Unsatisfactory.** Areas of concern: stove needs cleaning; service porch needs new tile; storage shed is filthy; a large suitcase is blocking an emergency exit; yard is filled with trash and dog waste; fuse box door needs repair and should be secured; graffiti on interior and exterior of house; stairwell banister is not secured; upstairs bathroom is not working; downstairs bathtub needs recaulking; carpet is torn; and no screens on several 2<sup>nd</sup> story windows. Chair Montano reported this facility to DCFS and other concerned departments.

# Frances Foundation III - #46-1

Chair Montano visited this facility on June 21<sup>st</sup> and gave a rating of **Needs Improvement.** <u>Areas of concern</u>: the interior and exterior and ground of home need attention; supply of dishes/utensils are low; no driver's licenses or fingerprints on file for facility staff; bed frame is broken in the second bedroom; need more closet space; bathrooms are messy; the linens are locked up, but no key is available; there are no Life Books for residents; and facility staff had no keys to various locks. Chair Montano expressed her concern that this facility had no fire extinguishers, and which poses a safety hazard.

# West Hollywood Sheriff's Station

Vice Chair Stathatos and Commissioner Cannella visited this facility on June 16<sup>th</sup> and gave a rating of **Excellent** with <u>no areas of concern</u> observed or reported.

## **Beverly Hills Court Station**

Vice Chair Stathatos and Commissioner Cannella visited this facility on June 20<sup>th</sup> and gave a rating of **Satisfactory** with <u>no areas of concern</u> observed or reported.
