PARCEL NO. 18 TO LEASE NO.70: PARCEL NO. 1117 - MARINA DEL REY

THIS AMENDMENT TO LEASE made and entered into this Lay of MARCH.

BY AND BETWEEN

COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, hereinafter referred to as "County"

AND

MARINA PACIFIC ASSOCIATES
hereineser referred to 64 "Lessee".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on the 28they of June 1963 the parties hereto, or their predecessors in interest, entered into Lesse No. 7073, under the terms of which County lessed to Lessee that certain real property located in the Marine del Ray Small Craft Harbor, County of Los Angeles, State of California, commonly known as Partial LLT which lessehold premises (the "Premises") are more particularly and legally described in Exhibit "A" stached to and incorporated in said Lesse, as amended (the Lesse and all amendments are collectively hereafter referred to se the "Lesse") and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to arrand the provisions of the Lease relating to the payment of rent to the County for any new and used boat sales activities and/or boat brokerage activities undertaken on the Premises; and

WHEREAS, the parties further wish to amend the provisions of the Lague to require that the Lagues demonstrate to the County that any subsesses proposing to conduct the activities specified in the immediately preceding racial on the Premises has been informed of the revised ractal obligations of the Lagues to the County created by this amendment at the time that the involved actionse is created, amended or assigned;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements, coverants and conditions contained herein, the parties, and each of them, agree as follows:

1. Commencing on the Effective Date, subsection (d) of section 13 (PERCENTAGE RENTALS) is replaced, in its entirety, with the following:

*(d)(1) For new or used boat sales, the greater of:

A. ONE Par Cent (1%) of gross receipts from new or used boat or boat trailer sales including credits for used items taken in trade as part

- payment ... new items, as reflected in the bill of ... However, the trade-in allowance for such used item taken in trade may be deducted from the sale price of said used item, provided said used item is sold within one hundred menty. (120) days of the date of the bill of sale which established said trade-in allowance; or
 - 8. FIFTEEN CENTS (\$0.15) per square foot per month of landside outdoor display area, if any, utilized for the sales activity plus rent awad, if any, pursuant to subsection (c) of this section 13, for office space utilized for the sales activity."
 - "(d)(2) ONE per Cart (1%) of gross receipts from the sale of house trailers and trailer cabanas including credits for used items taken in trade as part payment for new items, as reflected in the bill of sale. However, the trade-in allowance for such used item taken in trade may be deducted from the sale price of said used item, provided said used item is sold within one hundred menty (120) days of the date of the bill of sale which established said trade-in allowance."
 - "(d)(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Lacce, the monetary amount specified in subsection (d)(1)(B) of this section 13 shall be adjusted consumeraty with each date that eltrer square fact or percentage rent is to be readjusted in any manner pursuant to section 15, hereof, to the amount that is equal to severity five percent (75%) of the average monthly rent payable to the County per square foot of land for all perceis lessed by the County to third perses within Marine del Ray for which the County receives at least twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per year in gross rental income."
- 2. Commercing on the Effective Date, exhaution (e) of eaction 13 (PERCENTAGE RENTALS) is replaced, in its entirety, with the following:
 - *(e)(1) For boat brokerage activities, the greater of:
 - A FIVE Per Cent (5%) of book brokerage commission or other rises semad from book brokerage; or
 - B. FIFTEEN CENTS (\$0.15) per square foot per month of landside outdoor display area, if any, utilized for the boot brokerage activity plus rent owed, if any, pursuant to subsection (c) of this section 13, for office space utilized for the boat brokerage activity."

- (e)(2) Five Per Cant (5%) of commissions or other fees semed from car rental agencies, marine insurance commissions where the sale of insurance is conducted in conjunction with boat sales and/or boat brokerage, telephone service charges, laundry and dry cleaning commissions and other similar activities where semings are normally on a commission basis when said activity is approved in advance by Director."
- "(e)(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Lease, the momentary emount specified in subsection (e)(1)(8) of this section 13 shall be adjusted concurrently with each date that either square fool or percentage rent is to be readjusted in any manner pursuant to section 15, hereof, to the amount that is equal to severily five percent (75%) of the average monthly rent payable to the County per square foot of land for all perceis leased by the County to third perties within Marine del Rey for which the County receives at least twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) per year in gress rental income."
- 3. Commencing on the Effective Data, section 22 (SUBLEASES, ASSIGNMENTS, TRUST DEED BENEFICIARIES, MORTGAGEES AND SUCCESSORS) is amended by adding the following paragraph at the end of subsection (A)(1):

"Without limiting the foregoing, any proposed commercial sublease, or any emercinent or explanant of an existing commercial sublease covering new or use.! bost sales or bost brokkings activities, shall demonstrate to the complete satisfaction of the Director that the rental psyment obligations of the subleases to the Lessee reflect the financial benefits provided by the County to the Lessee as set forth in subsections (d)(1) and/or (e)(1) of section 15 of this Lesse."

4. Except as herein specifically amended, all larms, conditions and provisions of the Lease shall be and continue to remain in full force and effect and are undenedified, and each of the parties herein realisms and reactinoviedges their respective obligations under the Lease as amended hereby.
