The role of the RN is to ensure all workforce members have met regulatory requirements for health clearance and periodic surveillance, including the immunity to communicable diseases and hazardous materials.

Hours may vary between (7:00 am- 17:00 pm) Monday- Friday.

This position is responsible for but not limited to:

- Civil Service and other pre-placement examinations
- Annual health surveillance
- Blood bore pathogen exposure evaluation and follow-up
- Aerosol transmissible disease exposure evaluation and follow-up
- Asbestos and Antineoplastic exposure surveillance
- Respiratory Protection program surveillance, testing and training
- Comply with the various federal and state laws and regulations, accreditation requirements, and Departmental policies governing health evaluations and screenings for employment and required medical follow-up and surveillance activities to protect the health of patients and workforce members.

Qualifications:

- License to practice as a Registered Nurse issued by the state of California
- Reachable on the Relief Nurse/Registered Nurse I certification list or currently on the Relief Nurse/Registered Nurse I item
- Maintain current BLS certification
