RN Loan Repayment / Scholarship Program

Programs are available to assist those who have a desire to pursue a career as a Registered Nurse. There are a total of three programs available: Associate Degree Nursing Scholarship Program, Registered Nurse Bachelor of Science Nursing (BSN) Scholarship Program, and Registered Nurse BSN Loan Repayment Program. Each program has the same minimum requirements. These details are described in further detail below. In addition, \$10.00 of every Registered Nurses renewal fee goes to the Loan Repayment / Scholarship Program.

PROGRAMS:

- Associate Degree Nursing Scholarship Program Assists students with their AA degree
 in Nursing. The student must agree to obtain a BSN within 5 years of obtaining the AA degree.
 Maximum amount is \$8,000 for one academic year.
- Registered Nurse BSN Scholarship Program Assists students with obtaining a BSN. Maximum amount is \$10,000 for one academic year.
- Registered Nurse BSN Loan Repayment Program Repays up to \$10,000 in educational debts incurred while attending a BSN program. Awardees may reapply for an additional loan repayment at the completion of their 2-year service obligation.
 Maximum loan repayment award is \$20,000.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- California resident
- US citizen or permanent resident
- Financial need
- Agreement to practice nursing in a medically underserved area. For example, the County of Los Angeles, Department of Health Services Hospitals and Clinics meets the requirement as medically underserved areas.
