Position: Harbor UCLA Medical Center Department of Emergency Medicine (DEM) is currently seeking highly qualified individuals to fill the positions of Supervising Staff Nurse I (SSN I) to provide supervision and direction to emergency nursing staff caring for patients in the Adult and Pediatric Emergency Areas.

This position is responsible for but not limited to:

- Performs first level nursing and administrative supervisory functions
- Assigns employees daily to perform nursing tasks on the basis of available skills and with consideration for the needs of each patient
- Sets priorities and redirects employees to other tasks as the need arises
- Oversees the work of nursing personnel and instructs them in providing technical care to ensure compliance with standards of care and policies and procedures.
- Collaborates with a multidisciplinary group to ensure patient care delivered in safe effective manner
- Investigates and resolves patient, visitor or staff complaints in a timely manner, and reports findings to the nurse managers.
- Ensures compliance with standards of care and timeliness of triage assessments, medical screening exams, reassessments, direct patient care, and rapid patient throughput and patient satisfaction
- Provides expert nursing guidance and leadership to all of the Emergency Nursing Service Areas of the Department of Emergency Medicine

Qualifications:

- License to practice as a Registered Nurse issued by the state of California
- Must be reachable on the Supervising Staff Nurse I Certification list or hold the position of a Supervising Staff Nurse I
- Three years' experience of Registered Nurse Emergency Department experience

Desirable Skills:

- Bachelor's Degree in Nursing from an accredited School of Nursing
- Excellent interpersonal skills, professional and positive demeanor.
- Strong organizational, team building, critical thinking and conflict resolution skills
- BLS/ACLS/PALS/Non-Violent Physical CI Certifications
