At both TTCF and CRDF Mental Health and Discharge Planning services are provided to clients housed in mental health housing areas of the jail and seriously mentally ill special populations in the general population. WRS is a women's outpatient program in South Central Los Angeles. WRS offers a full range of outpatient services to women who have recently been released from jail and/or have a history of incarceration.
