TYPES OF ELIGIBLE IMMIGRATION STATUS

- □ 1. **NON-CITIZEN IMMIGRANT** [section 101(a)(15)] lawfully admitted under the Immigration Nationality Act (check the box applicable to you):
 - Permanent Resident [section 101(a)(20)]
 - Special Agriculture Worker (lawful temporary status) [section 210/210A]
- □ 2. AMNESTY: Non-citizen who entered the United States before January 1, 1972, or such later date as enacted by law, and has continuously maintained residence in the United States, and who is NOT ineligible for citizenship but who is deemed to be lawfully admitted for permanent residence as a result of an exercise of discretion by the Attorney General under section 249 of the INA [8 U.S.C., 1259].
