# **FEMA LOCAL ASSISTANCE CENTER TO OPEN SATURDAY IN ALTADENA**

*Altadena Community Center Will House Assistance Facility,  
Open 7 Days a Week from 8 am to 6 pm*

**ALTADENA --** The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will open a satellite Local Assistance Center at the Altadena Community Center on Saturday, February 12, 2005, announced Supervisor Michael D. Antonovich.

“President Bush’s announcement that FEMA has authorized federal aid and an Emergency Assistance Center in Altadena will bring much-needed support to County residents impacted by the January 2005 rainstorms,” said Supervisor Antonovich.

Affected property and business owners are encouraged to report damages and teleregister by calling the FEMA hotline at 800-621-FEMA and obtain a registration number before going to the Local Assistance Center.

FEMA will determine the locations of additional satellite centers based upon the volume of damage reports received by FEMA.

The Altadena Community Center is located at 730 E. Altadena Drive in Altadena and will be open from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm seven days a week.
