Hugh A. Thatcher served as county supervisor for one term. He assumed office on Dec. 3, 1930.

Thatcher was born in Iowa on July 13, 1876. In 1889, when he was 13, his family moved to Southern California.

During his term as county supervisor for the First District, Thatcher was chairman of the flood control committee. After leaving public office in 1934, he sought re-election in 1938 but was defeated in a close run-off election.

In later years Thatcher went into private practice as head of a Pomona investment firm.

In June 1957, Thatcher died. He was almost 81, and was survived by his wife, Ida, son Currier, and five grandchildren.
