NARRATIVE:

Alejandro Sanchez is a documented sex offender and has an extensive adult criminal history that began at the age of 31. His convictions include assault to commit rape, domestic violence, multiple cases of failing to register as a sex offender and disobeying a court order. He has served multiple state prison terms, the longest being a 2 year term for assault to commit rape. Sanchez was released from state prison to the supervision of the Los Angeles County Probation Department on January 1, 2012. Under the Governor's Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011, better known as Assembly Bill 109 (AB 109) the responsibility of lower-level offenders was shifted from the State to Los Angeles County. He subsequently failed to report to his probation officer and an arrest warrant was issued in March 2012 after he absconded from post release community supervision (PRCS). Sanchez qualified to be released to the supervision of probation, under AB 109, because his current commitment offense for failing to register a sex offender is defined as non-serious and non-violent under the California penal code. His criminal history, sex offender status and current failure to comply with the terms of release make him a most wanted. If you know his whereabouts please contact...
