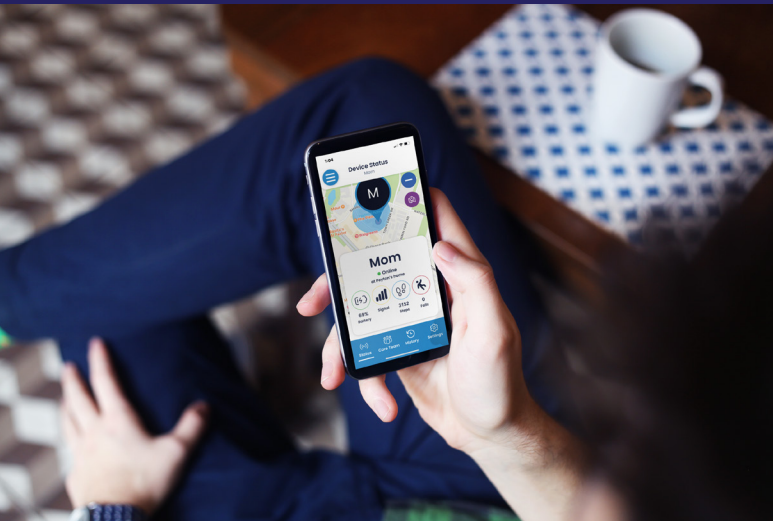




Find Your Loved One Quickly



If you have a loved one with Alzheimer's, dementia or Autism, wandering is one of the situations you will have to manage.

You are not alone - the Alzheimer's Association research shows that 74% of persons with Alzheimer's and dementia wandered from home: walking, bicycling, driving or public transportation. According to Autism Speaks, nearly half (49 percent) of parents reported that a child with ASD had attempted to wander or run away at least once after age 4. Usually, there was no forewarning; missing incidents happen during previously normal, non-wandering activities.

While many do not wander far, they will conceal themselves for protection, making them more difficult to locate. Help is here - today's technology can help you stay connected to your loved ones.

As busy caregivers you can't be there all the time. You can't rely on strangers to help, or that your loved one will conveniently go wandering in an urban environment where they are more likely to be found. You also cannot rely on them speaking up when they need help. Having a GPS tracking watch helps you know where they are so they can be recovered in minutes, not days. A tracking wearable with 2-way hands-free voice communication lets you speak to them directly and reassure them that help is on the way, or communicate with someone near them who can help.

The Theora Connect™ smart wearable and the Theora Link Pro™ smartphone app will keep you connected.



The Theora Connect is a wearable wristwatch that offers analog, digital, or date/time watch faces. The location of the watch is shown on the caregiver's cell phone with the Theora Link pro app. It will provide alerts if the wearer leaves a safe location. It has an SOS button to allow the wearer to call a trusted family member and the caregiver can also connect directly to the watch to allow the caregiver to communicate immediately with the wearer in case of an emergency. This 2-way voice communication does not require the wearer to answer an incoming call, the watch will automatically answer any number associated with the wearable. This capability allows nearby people to assist your loved one too.

Key Features



Safe Zones – set up geofences for any location, anytime so you are alerted when your loved one enters or exits a Safe Zone.



Quik Connect – call your loved one anytime, the wearable will automatically answer and you are connected.



SOS button – at any time, your loved one can call you when they need help.



Low battery notifications – helps you keep your loved one's wearable charged and ready.



No spam – only phone numbers set up in Theora Link can call the wearable.

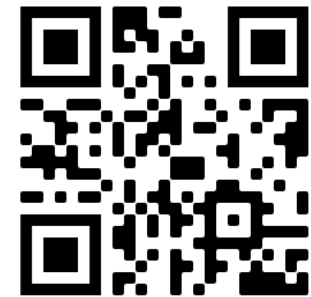
