Thank you for responding to the ANNUAL WEED ABATEMENT NOTICE; we are pleased you have decided to maintain your property.

In order to coordinate our clearing efforts, please arrange to have your parcel(s) cleared by: Deadline Date, when our County crews will be working and inspecting parcels in your area for hazardous weeds, brush or trash. After this date, if your parcel(s) requires clearing of any hazards, County crews may perform the necessary work with the costs assessed upon the property.

While the County is prohibited from making a profit from nuisance abatement work, it must recover all expenses incurred in performing this work. It is estimated that if County crews do the work, the charges will be approximately **\$3,300**.

Please remember that it is your responsibility to maintain the property hazard free and fire safe throughout the year. Regrowth or debris accumulation can create new hazards in the future that will require abatement by you or County crews.
