PROJECT; APPROVE PROJECT BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ADJUSTMENT;
AND ADOPT YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PLAN
CAPITAL PROJECT NO. 87117
(FOURTH DISTRICT) (3 VOTES)

#### SUBJECT

Approval of the recommended actions will approve the Capital Project budget, appropriation adjustment, and scope of work consisting of repaving two parking lots at La Mirada Community Regional Park.

#### IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

- Find the proposed actions categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act in accordance with Section 15302 (c) of the State California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, because the proposed Project consists of replacement of existing facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.
- 2. Approve the La Mirada Community Regional Park Parking Lot Improvement Project (Capital Project No. 87117), with a budget of \$285,000.

- 3. Approve the appropriation adjustment in the amount of \$285,000 offset by County Excess Funds available to the Fourth Supervisorial District from the Los Angeles County Safe Neighborhood Parks Proposition of 1996 for the La Mirada Community Regional Park Parking Lot Improvement Project Capital Project No. 87117.
- 4. Adopt the Youth Employment Plan as required by the Regional Parks and Open Space District Grant Programs' Procedural Guide.
- 5. Authorize the Department of Parks and Recreation to carry out the Project through a Board-approved Job Order Contract.

#### PURPOSE /JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of the recommended action will allow the Department of Parks and Recreation (Department) to refurbish two parking lots at La Mirada Community Regional Park. The existing parking lots are damaged and in need of repair.

The proposed Project consists of the removal, replacement, and restriping of approximately 102,350 square-feet of deteriorating concrete asphalt, for the north and south parking lots. In addition, the south and north parking lots will be resealed and restriped.

The Project is fully funded by the Safe Neighborhood Parks Proposition of 1996 (Proposition A of 1996) which requires that your Board adopt a Youth Employment Plan (Attachment III).

This Project will be managed and administered by the Department and construction will be carried out through the Department's Job Order Contracts (JOC) Program approved by your Board on June 15, 2010.

#### Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

Approval of the recommended action supports County Strategic Plan goals of Operational Effectiveness (Goal 1), by completing the work in the most efficient and cost-effective manner; and Children, Family, and Adult Well-Being (Goal 2), by publicizing affordable, accessible, educational, and cultural opportunities at La Mirada Community Regional Park.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The total Project cost for these facility enhancements, including construction, miscellaneous expenditures, and County services, are currently estimated at \$285,000. The Project Schedule and Budget Summary are included in Attachment I.

Approval of the appropriation adjustment (Attachment II) will provide \$285,000 in County Excess Funds available to the Fourth Supervisorial District from the Los Angeles County Safe Neighborhood Parks Proposition of 1996 to fully fund the La Mirada Parking Lot Improvement Project, Capital Project No. 87117.

Upon your Boards approval of the appropriation adjustment, sufficient appropriation will be available for implementation of the La Mirada Park Parking Lot Improvement Project.

#### **Operating Budget Impact**

Following completion of the Project, the Department does not anticipate any additional one-time or ongoing costs. The provisions of the Project have operating and maintenance requirements, which will be fulfilled with existing park staff and resources.

#### FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The proposed Projects are exempt from your Board's Civic Art Policy adopted on December 7, 2004, since the total Project value is less than \$500,000.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved this recommendation as to form.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION**

The proposed Project is categorically exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) according to Section 15302 (c) of the State CEQA Guidelines and Class 2(e) of the Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines adopted by your Board on November 17, 1987, because the proposed Project consists of replacement of existing facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.

#### **CONTRACTING PROCESS**

This authority will allow the Department the ability to procure a JOC to complete the proposed Projects.

#### **IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

Approval of these actions will have positive impacts on the current services by alleviating dangerous pot holes and trip hazards, and improving and enhancing parking opportunities available to park patrons. Project construction will be initiated during non-peak periods to minimize impacts to park patrons and will take approximately 45 days to complete. The north and south parking lots will be done separately to minimize impacts to park programming, ensuring the availability of adequate parking during construction activities. Signage will also be included to notify park patrons about construction activities and will provide instructions on alternative parking locations.

# COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION (LA MIRADA PARKING LOT PROJECT) (C.P. NO. 87117), (GRANT NO. P055-11-2254) YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PLAN

#### **BACKGROUND (Scope of Work)**

The proposed project consists of the removal, replacement, and restriping of approximately 102,350 square feet of deteriorating concrete asphalt to a depth of four inches, for the south parking lot, which runs along Adelfa Drive; and the north parking lot, which runs along Foster Road and Adelfa Drive. In addition, the south and north parking lots will be resealed and restriped.

#### Tasks that may be performed by At-Risk Youth

There are no tasks suitable for youth to perform on this project. However, the Department will utilize youth for general maintenance and servicing, including, grounds maintenance and programming whenever feasible.

#### **Estimated Cost of Youth Employment**

The Department has a youth employment budget and employs youth whenever feasible. The cost of using youth is flexible and dependent upon the services needed.

#### Method of Youth Employment

The Department employs youth to work in various areas of the Department through its Youth Enhancing Parks Program (YEPP). This program recruits youth to work on projects based on their training, experience, and physical class. In addition, the Department requires contractors to make a good faith effort to employ at-risk youth from the community where the project is being implemented.

#### Youth Employment Goal:

The Youth Employment Goal (YEG) established for the County of Los Angeles was \$15,739,507.43. As of March 2011, the YEG amount for the County exceeds \$18.8 million.
