Efforts to Reduce the Jail Population

The Los Angeles Sheriff's Department (LASD) continues to utilize various methods to manage the inmate population, including but not limited to: leaving the misdemeanor bail admitted at 50K; having been raised from 25K, applying accelerated releases for all inmates by 30 days using CA Penal Code 4024.1 PC, keeping the percentage release at 10% of their court ordered sentences for non-violent charges, and releasing short sentences if they are less than 240 days and non-violent charges. On October 1st, 2023, Pre-Arraignment Release Protocols (PARP) began and helped divert additional inmates that would have otherwise entered the county jail system. LASD has been working with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to coordinate the transfer of inmates sentenced to state prison. The number of inmates awaiting transfer to CDCR (SP – SP4) has dropped significantly from 1,171 in the beginning of January, to 1,048 during the first quarter, and is currently down to 737 SP-SP4 inmates. During quarter 1 there were 233 SP4 inmates, which has now been reduced to 137 SP4 inmates. All paperwork is processed and pending transfer to CDCR.

Additionally, LASD has been working with State Hospitals to further reduce the incarcerated population. At the beginning of January 2023, there were 593 inmates awaiting transfer to state hospitals. During the first quarter, the population of incarcerated individuals with medical needs was reduced to 353 inmates, as of the third quarter there are 225. LASD continues to collaborate with the Office of Diversion and Reentry (ODR) on diverting qualified incarcerated individuals to ODR releases, who otherwise would have gone to state hospitals.

LASD continues to collaborate with the Chief Executives Office (CEO), Justice, Care and Opportunity (JCOD) and the ODR for those incarcerated individuals that are sentenced to Court Ordered Programs and have been waiting extended times for beds. In July, there were 245 incarcerated individuals waiting to be transferred to programs. Of those, 25 waited more than 90 days and 73 waited over 30 days. Currently, there are 226 inmates, with 11 having waited over 90 days, and 44 waiting over 30 days. More than half of the 226 inmates have had less than a two week wait. This reduction in wait time indicates significant improvement brought on by the efforts of LASD and partnership programs.

Ongoing reassessments are conducted to identify appropriate housing and to mitigate any unnecessary operational delays.
