## III. AB 109 ONE-TIME FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION AND POTENTIAL ACTION OF SUPPORT

- a) Department of Health Services Integrated Correctional Health Services (DHS-ICHS)
  - <u>ICHS Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) Migration</u> <u>and Phone Replacement</u> – \$103,000 to support the move from the LASD Call Manager to the DHS Call Manager, which would serve to upgrade the telecommunications infrastructure
  - <u>ICHS Computer Upgrades for Mental Health</u> <u>Services</u> – \$343,000 to upgrade computers for security compliance for mental health staff
  - <u>ICHS Operations / Space Renovations</u> \$1,000,000 to renovate space to support the operational and infrastructure needs of increased staff and expansion of programs
- b) Justice, Care, and Opportunities Department (JCOD)
  - <u>Rapid Diversion Program</u> \$4,840,000 to create a streamlined pathway out of the criminal courts and into services for justice-involved individuals who meet certain mental health diversion criteria at two additional participating courthouses
- c) Department of Public Health Substance Abuse Prevention and Control (DPH-SAPC)
  - <u>Recovery-Oriented Permanent Housing</u> \$2,200,000 to create housing units for recovery-oriented, lowbarrier, abstinence-based permanent housing environment for justice-involved individuals who are in recovery from SUD and at risk of experiencing homelessness



- d) Public Defender's Office
  - <u>Resentencing Project Continuity Funding</u> \$4,167,000 for Post-Conviction Unit to fund legal services for individuals identify as eligible for resentencing pursuant to recent legislation
  - <u>Paralegal Intern Program</u> \$1,250,000 to fund paralegal interns to support Public Defender attorneys and paralegals with case management and legal administrative tasks
