Discussion on list of "meet and confer" items provided by LASD and impacts on the Commission and the community. There are 59 "meet and confer" items that remain open, going back to January 28, 2020. These include: Measure R (enacted by voters in March 2020), state law enacted through AB 847 (state law is outside the scope of representation), and LASD policy banning exclusive, discriminatory, and secretive deputy cliques; and station and

unit logos (including inflammatory insignias like the Fort Apache logo still in use at the East Los Angeles Station of LASD, and subject of 2019 COC resolution to eliminate.
