

# APPLYING PREVENTION & PROMOTION TO SUPPORT THRIVING: EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES AND YOUTH WELL BEING

## PRIMARY



**General public investment in youth activities, mentoring, and programs; educational and cultural programming to foster inclusion and belonging, community resources for parents and caregivers, including universal childcare and child tax credit**

## SECONDARY



**Publicly-funded services, mentoring, tutoring, and other activities geared toward youth and communities with fewer resources/who face greater barriers; scholarships for underrepresented and/or low-income students**

## TERTIARY



**Foster care and transitional programs, rehabilitation programs, academic supports and remedial classes for lower-performing students, behavioral health resources and therapy (e.g., for youth experiencing trauma)**

## REMEDY



**Youth justice diversion programs, dropout reentry programs, GED and adult education programs and training; behavioral health resources and therapy (e.g., re: childhood trauma)**
