78. Inspection Detail for #:

Commissioners Veral and Sherman conducted a site visit to the Hollywood Courthouse lockup to examine for overcrowding. We did not see overcrowding on our inspection, however, we were told by LASD that they do frequently hit capacity and need to turn people away from the lockup facility. There is no medical or psychiatric services available to individuals while they wait in the lockup, even though the courthouse is primarily responsible for cases involving people with mental health issues.

LASD Sgt. Farhat presented his knowledgeability of the facility operations. He described some challenges that he commonly faces, which include the lockup facility reaching capacity leading to requests to stop transferring individuals to the facility for their proceedings. He also described some of the challenges of housing individuals with serious mental illness. For example, when individuals spread feces in the cell, he stated LASD will respond promptly to the situation to remove the person from that cell and have it cleaned. He stated that people will not languish in such conditions, and that it is usually not a difficult situation that can often be resolved simply by offering the person a new, clean cell.

After inspection, Commissioners sat in a courtroom (Judge Kaye) and watched a proceeding that involved a request by prosecutors for a court order to extract the individual from his cell at Twin Towers. Judge Kaye declined to order the extraction. Commissioners heard comments by Judge Kaye, who requested LASD to produce some documentation of the steps taken to encourage the individual to leave the cell on their own volition prior to ordering an extraction. He made reference to County Counsel declining to disclose information about steps taken, and so had requested CHS to explain the steps that had been taken.
