49.	Inspection Detail for #:
	Sergeant A Farfan (afarfan@lasd.org) was the watch sergeant when we arrived. There was a use of force going on in 242. Sergeant had on Fox News.
	One man had just returned from court and was waiting to be cleared to go to the community. He also did not receive his inhaler. Inmate had just returned from court, was very stressed out and did not have food. He couldn't eat at court because he was stressed about his case - he had returned without a sandwich or anything to eat. We waited until the guards gave him a sandwich.
	Deputy Fernandez was very helpful. Other staff were not. They were exceptionally skeptical and contrarian about issues we raised.

	271 B EBI/MOH
	Module B - the TV cable didn't work. The water was very hot, over 100 degrees. One gentleman in that dorm came from the state prison as EOP mental health, and it took them 10 months in the county to get him his meds even though he had been on them for years in prison.  What policies does LASD/CHShave communicate when people transfer intra-custody for hearings? (Esp with CDCR on resentencing).
	Veterans dorn was in 271F. There was a poster advertising that people could inquire about getting into the veteran dorm on the wall of the actual dorm. The info was vetnotifications@LASD.org or 213-893-6792. The veteran's dorm 271F was full - 30 people. One gentleman I spoke to said he arrived at the LA Jails in January, and it took until mid-July for him to be transferred there. He said he is much more stable there now. They have groups, CBT, positive thinking, and life skills. Do they have the ability to expand? Is there a
	waiting list?  Big picture issue. Is there a way for the people who get released from court to be screened at the court for mental acuity or mental health issues rather than having to get sight clearance at the jail? It appears that people are being forced to spend a day or two extra in custody to have that evaluation, and they generally are acceptable.
51.	Inspection Detail for #:
	Note from 242: the papers that are attached outside cell doors are often inaccurate. One said that an individual was able to have his retainer on his property, but when we asked for him, we were told that his note was inaccurate because he was on suicide watch. Other notes also had inaccuracies.
	Note from 271: There is one person who speaks a language that no other inmate in 271 speaks and there has as of yet not been translation services provided for him. Deputies told us because all access to internet is cut off for them, they cannot google or google translate anything to him either. This individual was requesting medical help.
	271 EBI: There are no Spanish books available, except for the Bible. There is a request for a diversity of books.
	The Tower 2 visiting elevator is broken. Therefore, video visits are ONLY option. This elevator needs to be fully replaced, which is not set to take place until March. Broken elevators stop visits, particularly difficult for those who cannot use the video technology.
