

#### Access:

Commissioners knocked three times before a Deputy answered to let us in No grievance forms available A security check happened while Commissioners were present and it was very fast and the staff did not look in tented bunks. There is no vending machine in this dorm. There are some in the hallways but because of their classification they do not get to access it very often. Showers/Phones/TVs: 9 shower heads in total and only 3 work (only 1 consistently works) Observed water pressure and temp on those 3 were okay Observed black mold in shower on the floor and in the light fixtures One of the metal coverings on the wall in the showers is missing

One person made a request for partitions in the showered so a shred of privacy

2 of 5 phones have a short in their cords

2 TVs working

#### Blankets:

Multiple individuals complained of being low on blankets and receiving them once every 6 months Medical Attention:

Menstrual products were not made available and individuals have not received hormone treatments. Extreme physical pain was noted by multiple individuals that had not gone addressed by medical or prescriptions for immediate physical needs were not filled. These individuals issues were reported by the Commissioners to the Watch Commander.

#### Cleaning:

Individuals complained of the lack of cleaning supplies and a makeshift broom with a plastic handle and two socks was created to clean the floors. EBI/Conservation Credits:

The module reported access to EBI high school classes were lost in February when one participant was close to completion. They ended it because there were not enough people enrolled in the LGBTQ specific class offering in which only individuals from 5800, 9400, and 5900 are able to attend. Despite the 6:30 - 7:30am class time, enrollment was thought to be low because people get out causing the class numbers to drop. The person who was enrolled and close to finishing shared that there were about 5 people enrolled before they cancelled the program mid-completion.

Multiple individuals spoke about the lack of access to conservation credits. The staff feel it is unsafe for them to be trustees from a safety perspective, because of their classification, however they are porters and do jobs in their dorm that they feel also deserve credits. A result of not having trustees in the module is that food has been cut by other trustees and individuals don't get their full meals based on whether or not they are in favor with the trustee. One individual was getting food they were allergic to in their meals, which could cause a major physical threat to the person if consumed.
