### 99. Narrative Report

#### General:

All pods had ACLU posters, grievance forms, commissary list with pricing, Large TVs, one pod had a radio for men to have on handling portal to listen to. All additional supplies (food, books, snacks, etc.) are handled by mental health assistants. Recreation to go in day room or outside occurs 2x/daily. Overall consensus with incarcerated men is they were waiting to be discharged to a substance abuse/mental health treatment program in the community or waiting to be sentenced to possible state psychiatric hospital/ prison setting. Additionally, it was reported majority of men were not being transported to court appearances and were using video instead and visits with lawyer/family visits were not happening due to elevators issues and lack of effort to escort them.

There was no narcan in the pods.

Regular access to medical and request forms.

Majority of phones work but every pod had at least one that was out of commission.

They have a regular and reliable process for commissary.

Observed several elevators to enter the floors of tower were not in working order; elevator that was working is #5. Upon arrival on the 6th floor, noticed a rubber shoe as a door stopper.

Merit Masters and MHA are not eligible if they are sentenced. They facilitate classes for the other individuals incarcerated in their pod, including self care, court advocacy, and communications. Other EIB offered includes life skills and parents.

There was no tenting. Some had decorations/photos in their cells.

#### 161-A Pod

Observed turtle in tank-creates nature and relaxing environment

161 E cell- air conditioning fluctuates-Sometimes air does not circulate well; it can be too cold and other times too hot. Incarcerated person reported when he arrived in cell, vent was covered in peanut butter and paper and he had to remove debris himself.

161-B Pod- Spoke to incarcerated person in cell#14 and he reported that there is hot and cold water, meals (2 hot and 1 cold meal), receives snacks 2x/daily and medication arrive on time. He noted and requested that the pods will have emotional support/animal therapy will bring dog every Wednesday and expressed increase in mood and overall mental health. He requested, if possible, to have an additional day for the dog to come in. 2 phones were broken and 2 were in working order however sounded of static.

### 161 C-Pod

Observed barber supplies out in recreation area and mental health assistants available to help as needed.

Visible mold

Foulks, Malachi #6957264 was court ordered to attend the START program but was denied entry due to his being in HOH. This created confusion and worry he would be seen out of compliance for something out of his control.

### 161 D-

Terrelle Anderson #7003252- requested follow up on release as he was reported that his case was dismissed on june 20,2025, however after follow up with watch commander we learned he was on a metal health hold and is awaiting conservatorship decision,. He also requested more time to be outside for recreation and additional coffee time from 2x/day to 3x/day.

Showers only get cold water.

One individual requested more time out of cell either on the weekend, before 8 or after 5pm to connect with family members who are at work all day.

### 161E-Pod

cell #8- incarcerated person reported experiencing low water pressure in sink and air circulation from AC is not regulated well (can become too cold if air is on high)

### 161 F-Pod

Cell #2-incarcerated person reported left side of sink button does not work. He reported mental health assistants and deputies being helpful, receives daily showers and medication on time, noted receiving 2 cold and 1 hot meal daily and snacks.

Cell #4-toilet was observed to be covered in grime and dirty
