General Observations

Water/Plumbing Issues: Watch Commander advised of brown water, broken toilets, and broken sinks in the East Tower and booking area. An emergency plumbing order was called and en route. Broken doors were also noted.

Elevators: Functioning in both towers, with one still out of service on each side.

Food Concerns: Many incarcerated individuals complained of extreme hunger, particularly in 2300, shortly after dinner was served.

Module 2304

Cell #22: Toilet not working.

Cell #20: Sink not working.

Cell #18: Individual reported extreme hunger; requests evaluation for medical special diet.

Cell #17: Sink not draining.

Module 2302

Cell #11: Reported extreme hunger.

Cell #10: Ants in cell; sink not draining. Trash not removed regularly; incarcerated had to beg for toilet paper until commissioner intervened.

Complaint from incarcerated individual stating she was “forced to confess” to a court miss-out despite wanting to attend court. Alleged retaliation by Deputy Kim, including verbal harassment (“Your Hollywood carriage is not going to wait for you”). Displayed a tooth she claims was knocked out by a deputy. Expressed fear of continued retaliation and missing future court appearances.

Cell #9: Reported hunger and insufficient food; raised concerns about air quality, mold, lice, and lack of weekly showers.

Module 3100

Water/Plumbing: Majority of toilets and sinks not functioning by ~7:30 p.m.; observed brown water and small flies.

Cell #48: Toilet flushing on its own repeatedly.

Cell #15: Sink and toilet out.

Cell #16: Toilet out.

Cell #19: Toilet out, brown water.

Cell #24: Water leaking from wall. When the incarcerated raised this with deputies, she reported Deputy Salazar told her to “shut up and stop complaining.” Report of being denied bottled water and cleaning supplies.

Phones: Static reported in module.

Staffing Concern: During pill call, only one deputy observed managing the entire module, appearing to struggle with span of control. One “bubble” observed with 5+ deputies idle.

Medical: Multiple complaints that medical moves very slowly and requests go unfulfilled.

Module 2600 – Medical Concerns

Incarcerated individual rep kidney issues, leg swelling, hernia pain; awaiting follow-up from tests taken three weeks ago.

incarcerated in reported kidney stone issue, stomach pain, needs eyeglasses.

Incarcerated individual needs replacement wheelchair. Current chair missing arm padding and wheel malfunction.

Reports of individuals not receiving vegan/special diet meals.

Incarcerated individua reported awaiting Rabbi approval for Kosher meals. Believes only TTFC has rabbi availability; requests inclusion on CRDF rabbi visit list.

Acknowledgment by incarcerated individual expressed gratitude to medical for care received after last inspection.

Environmental/Health Concerns:

Visible worms, maggots, and small flies in sinks; brownish water. Bottled water currently being distributed.

Mold observed on walls (same as prior inspection).

Complaint that male deputies were watching women shower from upstairs section.

Cell #46: Sink clogged for past 2 weeks.

One upstairs shower malfunctioning. Chlorine smell reported at last inspection; took over one week to address.

Ongoing mail delivery issues.

Phones reported with static.

Cell #12 & #14: Visible gnats and worms in sinks; fear of long-term health consequences.

Food concerns: spoiled/uncooked food, rancid milk, rotten eggs, moldy bread; many complaints of hunger.

PREA / Safety Concerns:

Incarcerated individual reported being assaulted by Deputy in May 2025 in 2700. Stated retaliation from Sergeant since the report. Claims she is now being denied meals after previously receiving a special diet. During inspection, Deputy contacted kitchen; staff confirmed she had been removed from the diet list. Clarification requested was made to advise if diet order expires and should medically be re-authorize. Incident of reported assault was reported to Watch Commander upon exiting facility.

Summary of Key Concerns:

Plumbing and Water: Brown water, clogged/broken sinks and toilets, maggots, and mold remain pervasive across modules.

Food and Nutrition: Widespread complaints of hunger; spoiled/uncooked food; unclear handling of medical/special diet requests.

Medical: Multiple urgent follow-ups needed; delays in care and unfulfilled requests reported.

PREA Allegations: Serious concern regarding reported assault and retaliation; requires immediate review.

Deputy Conduct: Reports of verbal abuse, retaliation, and lack of responsiveness to incarcerated needs.

Safety and Oversight: Reports of male deputies observing women shower; inadequate deputy coverage during pill call.

Basic Hygiene & Supplies: Limited toilet paper, insufficient cleaning supplies, mail delays, static phone lines.

Positive Acknowledgment: Medical staff was thanked for following through on request made by individual from previous inspection
