Requested more disinfectants for dorm, which is a consistent concern since many people are immune compromised. Back pipe in dorm leaking causing a puddle on the floor	
• FISH Kits/Clothing/Mattresses: Multiple people mentioned bras and panties are not arriving in time or in the correct size for the trans population. Complaints about not receiving FISH kits for a while and it was significantly impacting gender expansive and transwomen in dorm who were not able to shave body hairs. Commissioners and BOS D2 staff passed out FISH request forms. Reported they have not received razors for nearly a month or more. Hygienic products like toothbrushes and shampoos are not sufficiently supplied because FISH kits don't get replenished. When Commissioners asked the Deputies, a Captain told us fish kits are available and can be made available. Commissioner saw 2 bunks without mattresses. One man in this dorm was advocating to receive those for the new people they added to the dorm. These requests had gone unanswered but they were bringing them up upon commissioners requests. We did not see the mattresses	
delivered. Taking 2-3 days to get mattresses and blankets • Learning: All books were taken away about a week ago with no reason given. Continued request to receive conservation credits for their "house mouse" services.
