- Phones: All of the phones have low volume or are static-y – only one phone was working
- Credits: Not getting credits transferred over and no opportunity to become trustees
- Hygiene: Saw dust caked on to all AC vents. Some mattresses without plastic. Men complained that the shower water runs out by the evening
- Food: 5 men reported that dinner continuously comes cold
- Visits: Complaints that visits are often impacted and loved ones are turned away even when they show 25 minutes early because it is not 30 minutes early

One man in this dorm was advocating to receive those for the new people they added to the dorm. These requests had gone unanswered but they were bringing them up upon commissioners requests. We did not see the mattresses delivered. Taking 2-3 days to get mattresses and blankets
