Module 1750 - A Row

Cell #22: Heavy rust stain along corner wall of cell.

Cell #19: Low sink water pressure; light has been broken for approximately two weeks.

Module 1750 - B Row

Cell #12: Low water pressure from sink.

Cell #15: Presence of roaches observed on floors and entering through wall cracks.

Cell #24 Incarcerated individual reported still awaiting follow-up on participation in the MAT program since last inspection.

Module 1750 - C Row

General Concern: Loved one submitted report regarding rodent infestation in C Row. Incarcerated individuals overall confirmed rodent presence in the jail, though only a few in C Row reported direct sightings.

Cell #7: Individual reported observing mice running on the floor and hearing movement between walls.

Cell #12 Incarcerated individual reported recent diabetes diagnosis. Experiencing frequent nighttime shaking over the past two weeks. Unable to monitor blood sugar levels and expressed fear of diabetic coma. Requested urgent medical follow-up and special diet.

Cell #23 Incarcerated individual reported excessive phlegm, difficulty breathing, and chest heaviness. Previous medical exam (July 2025) only checked blood pressure and cholesterol. Requests further testing (Jungs/blood). Attributes health issues to rodents, unsanitary conditions, and possible contamination of water pipes. Avoids sink water, reporting belief that rodents contaminate water supply.

Cell #24: Empty cell; observed to be dark with towels stuffed into toilet in attempt to block rodents/vermin from entering through water pipes.

Overall Observations and Concerns (Rows A, B, and C)

Televisions: Poor quality across all rows (scrambled/distorted pixels, no volume, inconsistent closed captions). Work order reportedly in progress.

Dayroom/Outdoor Access: Incarcerated men report no outdoor time since June; no dayroom access due to repairs (broken metal).

Cleaning Supplies: Request for more cleaning products across all rows.

Phones: Reported to be in working order.

Books/Materials: Deputies reported as responsive in providing reading materials, especially important with TVs not functioning properly.

Meals: Complaints of food consistently arriving cold, spoiled, or inedible.

Observation: one individual had two dinner trays; deputies reportedly allow distribution of extra trays when available.

Staff Conduct:

Commissioner Cumpian and I would like to highlight Deputy Henessey, who has consistently demonstrated respectful, professional, and pleasant demeanor. This is the third inspection where his helpfulness in answering questions and responsiveness to incarcerated individuals' needs has been observed.

Next Steps / Follow-Up:

Watch Commander Cardenas to address environmental concerns (rust, broken lights, low water pressure, pests, TV and dayroom issues, cleaning supplies, food quality).

Dr. Henderson to follow up on medical concerns, particularly for three incarcerated individuals-Diabetes management and urgent care, respiratory and other medical concerns and MAT program follow-up
